What is Paint to Music?

Paint to Music is a unique partnership between The Phoenix Symphony and Young Arts Arizona that fosters unified creativity in a student's approach to the aural and visual arts.

Everyone! All school-age students are invited to submit artwork created while listening to music selected from an upcoming Symphony for the Schools Program!



Let's Make Some Art! The process is easy! Simply turn on a recording of the fourth movement of Beethoven's Sixth Symphony, and as you listen to the music, create an inspired work of art!

Send your artwork to The Phoenix Symphony so it can be shown during a live performance at a Symphony for the Schools program next season!

### How to Complete a Paint to Music Project:



Explain that your student should draw what their hear in the music, or what they think the music means. Try to avoid giving a description of the music.



Anything is valid! Winning artwork has included everything from abstract reflections on the music to literal depictions of musical instruments to an anthropomorphic dancing taco.





In accordance with the guidelines, let the students select their preferred medium of self-expression. Art supplies should be close by.



Turn on a recording of the Fourth Movement of Beethoven's Sixth Symphony. And create! You may need to play the recording an additional time.





## **Guidelines:**

- Artwork should be created on a white sheet of paper or poster board and be no larger than 18" x 22".
- Artwork can be created in your or your student's choice of durable medium (crayon, paint, markers, etc...).
- An entry and release form should accompany each work of art sent to The Phoenix Symphony.

## Schedule:

#### August 31, 2020

Artwork submission deadline.

#### October 16, 2020

Artwork selected and incorporated into concert program.

#### Fall 2020

Selected student artwork will be on display at a local art gallery and some may tour with Young Arts Arizona, Ltd. More information will be emailed to everyone that submits artwork.

#### January 2021

All Artwork will be incorporated into the Symphony Field Trip Concert
