Widely regarded as the most beautiful ever written for the instrument, it features the brilliant cellist Johannes Moser, a laureate of the International Tchaikovsky Competition, as soloist. Opening the program is a work by Amanda Harberg, an American composer acclaimed for her beautiful music.

Opening the program is Christopher Cerrone's *The Age of Wire and String*, a six-part orchestral suite that Cerrone composed especially for his good friend Tito Muñoz to premiere.




